1.- GENERAL DESCRIPTION

This file provides the historical information of a race and the runners participating in it. You can also be associated with the UCI ranking by providing historical data of the riders included in it.

PRF	Prefix indicating that the file is a live match
CCCCC	Competition ID (5 digits)

NOTE1: StatsPerform Spain can add sections, new attributes in this model without first communicating to users. The current content will always be maintained.

2.- DESCRIPTION

2.1 Header

All xml files provided by StatsPerform Spain are in UTF-8 (8-bit Unicode Transformation Format) encoding format.

2.2 General Data Section <DG>

ID	Competition code
JOR	Competition day of race
TCOM	It Indicates the type of competition. 8= Indicates that it is a Ranking (UCI for example) 7= Indicates that it is a race
DEP	Sport ID 9 = Men's cycling 109 = Women's cycling
FN	File name
FG	Generic file.
IDUNICO	Unique id of the competition, every year/season the same
TEMP	Season of the competition, usually year when is takes place
TS	File generation date and time

If the competition is a race, it will contain the record of the race (three first places) of the last 20 years.
If it is ranking type, it will be empty.

Attributes	Description
IDPTO	Stand
ID	Rider ID (numeric)
NOM	Rider's name
CE	Team id. If the race is disputed by countries the team code is 0.
NBEQUIPO	Name of the rider's team. If the race is disputed by countries the ISO code (three letters) of the country with which you participate.
TIPO	If the race is a World Cup or Olympic Games type of test to which the position belongs, possible values: RUTA (Road) CRONO (Time Trial) In another case empty.

It consists of a group of sections each of which has the historical data of the riders who take part in the competition.

It has a group of sections that describe the rider's track record.

2.4.2.1 Cumulative Section <Acumulado>

Attributes	Description
TOURS	Number of times he has won the general classification of the Tour de France.
GIROS	Number of times he has won the general classification of the Giro d'Italia.
VUELTAS	Number of times he has won the general classification of the Vuelta a España.
C-ETAPAS	Number of times he has won the general classification of other stage races (UCI Pro Tour) that are none of the above.
CLASICAS	Number of times he has won one-day races (UCI Pro Tour)
E-TOUR	Number of stages he has won in the Tour de France
E-GIRO	Number of stages he has won in the Giro d'Italia
E-VUELTA	Number of stages he has won in the “La Vuelta”
E-OTRAS	Number of stages he has won in other stage races (UCI Pro Tour) which are none of the above.
MUNDIAL-CR-1	Times he has won the World Time Trial Cycling Championship (gold medal)
MUNDIAL-CR-2	Times he has won a silver medal in the world time trial.
MUNDIAL-CR-3	Times he has won a bronze medal in the World Time Trial Cycling Championships.
MUNDIAL-RT-1	Times he has won gold medal in the road cycling world championships.
MUNDIAL-RT-2	Times he has won silver medal in the road cycling world championships.
MUNDIAL-RT-3	Times he has won bronze medal in the road cycling world championships.
JO-CR-1	Times he has won a gold medal at the Olympic Games in cycling in the time trial specialty.

JO-CR-2	Times he has won silver medal at the Olympic Games in cycling in the time trial specialty.
JO-CR-3	Times he has won bronze medal at the Olympic Games in cycling in the time trial specialty.
JO-RU-1	Times he has won a gold medal at the Olympic Games in road cycling.
JO-RU-2	Times he has won a silver medal at the Olympic Games in road cycling.
JO-RU-3	Times he has won bronze medal at the Olympic Games in road cycling.
L-TOUR	Number of days in which he has been leader in the Tour.
L-LAP	Number of days in which he has been leader in the Giro.
L-VUELTA	Number of days in which he has been leader in the Vuelta.
L-OTHER	Number of days in which he has been leader in other races by stages (UCI Pro Tour) other than the previous ones.

History of results of the rider in the different seasons / years in which he took part in races.

2.4.1.2.1 Year/Season Section <TEMP>

Attributes	Description
ID	Season/year id
NBEQUIPO	Name of the team in which he raced that season
CE	Id of the team he belongs to on that season

2.4.1.2.1.1 Achievement achieved <ITEM>

Attributes	Description
TPAL	Type of awards, possible3 values: 1= Place in the general classification of a race. 2= Place in a Stage of a race 3= Race leader days
NAME	Race Name
IDCOMPEUNICO	ID of the competition over the years. It is not the id of a season; it is an id that permanent.
PUESTO	If the TPAL value is 1 or 2, place in the general or in the stage. If TPAL=3 does not exist
TIPO	If the TPAL value is 1 it says the specialty in which you obtained the position: Possible values: 1 = Time trial specialty. 0 = Route

	If TPAL=3 does not exist
NDIAS	If the TPAL value is 3 it says the number of days, it has been leading in the race. TPAL other than 3 does not exist.
