Xml standings description



1.- GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The standings xml files contain the standings of a competition for a specific round-day

The way to name these files follow the rule:

Normal Name: CSF_ccccc_dd.Xml

Generic name: CGF_ccccc.Xml

CSF	Prefix that identifies the file as a standing file
ccccc	competition code in 5 digits
dd	Stage/Grand Prix corresponding to the standing

CGF is a prefix that identifies the file as a generic standing file. The generic files are very useful in leagues because they always have the standing of the last day

Example:

CSF_00522_10 Xml standings of the first round of the World cup 2010

CFG_00400.Xml standing generic file of the Spanish league.

NOTE: *Opta España can add new attributes sections in this model without communicating previously to the users. Anyway the current content will be maintained.*
