1.- GENERAL DESCRIPTION

This kind of file contents info relate with the titles win by a team.

H02_ccccc.Xml

H02 is a fix prefix that identifies the type of file
cccc is the competition ID in 5 digits

Example:

H02_00841.Xml File for tema of the Spanish first division, season 2012-13

DES	Description of the file
DEP	Sport code, assigned by Opta. 1 = Football 2 = Football indoor 3 = Basket 4 = Handball 101 = Female football
FN	File name. These name is useful if this file is pulled via HTTP
FG	File Generic name. These name is useful if this file is pulled via HTTP
IDUNICO	Unique competition code across the seasons. Together the attribute TEMP can be the ID of the competition. If the file correspond to the data of one team then its value is 9999
TEMP	Journey/day played when the file was created.

An element by each type of Title

Name	Description
ID	Id of the Title
DES	Description of the title
IMP	Relevance of the title, Value given by Opta España, Possible values: empty and values between 1 -10. 1 is biggest relevance.

Section of teams which titles are included in the file

Section with the titles of a team

2.3.2.1.1 Title section “<TIT>”

An element by each title winned by the team

Name	Description
ID	Id of the title

2.3.2.1.1.1 Season-Year section “<TEM>”

An element by each season/year where the team winned the Title

Name	Description
ID	Id of the season format yyyy-yy or yyyy depending if the title is from a season or from a year.
