Xml rankings description



1.- GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The ranking xml files contain a group of rankings of o competition. Each ranking belong to a concept/action of the corresponding sport.

The way to name these files follow the rule:

OCF_ccccc_tt_xxxx.Xml

OCF is a fix prefix that identifies the file as a ranking file.

ccccc is the competition code in 5 digits.

tt identifies the type of rankings included (teams, players,...)

xxxx is a number that identifies the groups of rankings included in the file, this number is always the same for a customer.

Example:

OCF_00522_01_0180.Xml team rankings of the World cup 2010

OCF_00522_02_0179.Xml player ranking of the World cup 2010

NOTE: *Opta España can add new attributes sections in this model without communicating previously to the users. Anyway the current content will be maintained.*

IDXML	It is a number that identifies the kind of rankings included in the file. It is an internal attribute of Ota Spain
TIPXML	Type of rankings, 1 = Team rankings, 2 = players rankings
DSIG	Internal use of Opta, date, 48 hours before the next game starting
DEP	Sport code, assigned by Opta. See the appendix A
FN	File name. These name is useful if this file is pulled via HTTP
FG	File Generic name. These name is useful if this file is pulled via HTTP
CODE	Round ID played when the file was created 01= Final 02= semifinal 03 = Quarter 04 = Last 16 05 = 6th Round 06 = 5th Round 07 = 4th Round 08 = 3rd Round 09 = 2nd Round 10= 1st Round If the competition is like League then ID = 0
JOR	Journey/day played when the file was created.
TS	Time stamp when the file was created



2.3 Rankings section

In this section are included several rankings. The group of rankings included depends of the customer requirements. Anyway all rankings have the same structure and attributes.

The name of the section is “Equipos” if the rankings belong to teams and “Jugadores” belong to players.

2.3.1 Ranking section

Each ranking belong a type of concept/action of the corresponding sport. The concept will be specified in each OCF file.

Name	Description
ID	Position in the ranking
CE	Team ID
NE	Team name
TO	Number of actions in the whole competition
ME	Average in the competition (value by match played)

Attributes if ranking type is for Players

Name	Description
ID	Position in the ranking
CJ	Id of the player
NJ	Player name
CE	Team ID of the players
NE	Team name
TO	Number of actions in the whole competition
ME	Average in the competition. Number of minutes that the player needs to do and action of this type.
