FTP Push

The subscriber should prepare an FTP site for Opta to push XML files to. Opta will need the following information from the subscriber:

FTP Hostname

Username

Password

Directory to post files to

HTTP Push

Http push is available as an alternative means of distribution to the customer's webserver.

Delivery Timings

Once a production environment is established between Opta and the subscriber, Opta will deliver an initial file containing the current tournament's fixtures/results with all data up-to-date. The file will be then continued to be updated as necessary.

XML Future Updates

Opta hold the right to add Elements and Attributes to the XML structure without prior notice and can remove non-essential Elements and Attributes with two weeks' notice.
